SUBTITLE 2. ORGANIZATION AND AUTHORITY OF DEPARTMENT PERTAINING TO FORESTS AND PARKS — IN GENERAL.

5-201. ROLE OF DEPARTMENT IN GENERAL; TRANSFER OF JURISDICTION FROM DEPARTMENT OF FORESTS AND PARKS.

(A) ROLE OF DEPARTMENT IN GENERAL.—THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMOTE, ADMINISTER, AND MANAGE EVERY STATE—CWNED OR IEASED FOREST, PARK, SCENIC PRESERVE, NATURAL AREA, FARKWAY, HISTORIC MONUMENT, AND RECREATION AREA, ADMINISTER EVERY LAW AND RULE OR REGULATION RELATING TO FORESTS, PARKS, SCENIC PRESERVES, NATURAL AREAS, PARKWAYS, HISTORIC MONUMENTS, RECREATION AREAS, FIRE CONTROL, RCADSIDE TREES, THE RESTORATION OF DEFORESTED OR DENUDED AREAS, AND THE OPERATION OF THE STATE FOREST NURSERY.

(B) TRANSFER OF JURISDICTION OF DEPARTMENT OF FORESTS AND PARKS TO DEPARTMENT.— EVERY RIGHT, POWER, DUTY, OBLIGATION, AND FUNCTION CONFERRED UPON OR EXERCISED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FOREST AND PARKS IS TRANSFERRED TO AND EXERCISED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
