AND UTILIZATION OF THE LANDS. IT MAY SELL OR DISPOSE OF PRODUCTS FROM THE LANDS, AND MAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION. ANY REVENUE RECEIVED FROM THE LANDS SHALL BE PAID INTO THE STATE TREASURY TO THE CREDIT OF THE FOREST OR PARK RESERVE FUND [[AND DISBURSED]] IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF [[§ 5-1302]] §5-212. HOWEVER, AT LEAST 50 PERCENT OF THE GROSS REVENUES DERIVED FROM THE LANDS MAY BE DEVOTED TO THE PAYMENT OF ANY OBLIGATIONS FOR THE PURCHASE INCURRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION, UNTIL THE OBLIGATIONS ARE FULLY PAID.

5-208. EMINENT DOMAIN.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY CONDEMN LAND, EARTH, GRAVEL, STONE, TIMEER, MATERIAL, OR ANY IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NAME OF THE STATE WHEN ACTION IS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSE OF ANY LEGISLATIVE ACT OR ADVANCE THE AIMS OF FORESTRY, PARKS, OR RECREATION, AND THE WORK OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT MAY PAY ANY COST AND EXPENSE INCURRED OUT OF ANY SURPLUS MONEY STANDING TO THE CREDIT OF THE FOREST RESERVE OR PARK RESERVE FUNDS, NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO LAND LOCATED WITHIN BALTIMORE CITY.

5-209. RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY MAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF ORDER, SAFETY, SANITATION, TRAFFIC CONTRCL, OR FOR THE PROTECTION OF TREES AND OTHER PROPERTY AND THE PRESERVATION OF THE NATURAL BEAUTY WITHIN THE STATE PARKS AND FORESTS, STATE RESERVES, SCENIC PRESERVES, PARKWAYS, HISTORICAL MONUMENTS,
