

CARE AND WHO, WHETHER IN HIS OWN BUSINESS OR AS THE EMPLOYEE OF ANOTHER PERSON AND WHETHER UNDER THE TITLE OF ARBORIST, TREE SPECIALIST, TREE SURGEON, TREE EXPERT, OR OTHERWISE, ENGAGES IN THE BUSINESS OR WORK OF THE TREATMENT AND CARE OF TREES FOR COMPENSATION BY MAKING DIAGNOSES, PRESCRIBING, AND SUPERVISING THE TREATMENT FOR TREES.

5-416. APPLICANTS TO BE EXAMINED BY DEPARTMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT MAY EXAMINE APPLICANTS FOR LICENSING AS TREE EXPERTS AND PASS UPON THEIR COMPETENCE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 66C, section 402 of the Code. The last sentence is proposed for deletion as inconsistent with departmental reorganization pursuant to Chapter 348, Acts of 1972. The only other changes made are in style.

5-417. LICENSE REQUIRED; EXEMPTION.

A PERSON MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE WORK OR BUSINESS OF A TREE EXPERT WITHOUT A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PART. AN EMPLOYEE, UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED TREE EXPERT MAY NOT BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A LICENSE IN HIS OWN NAME.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 66C, section 400A of the Code together with the fourth paragraph of Article 66C, section 401 of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

5-418. ISSUANCE OF LICENSES; QUALIFICATIONS; INSURANCE.

(A) QUALIFICATIONS.—THE DEPARTMENT MAY EXAMINE AN APPLICANT FOR LICENSE AS A TREE EXPERT AND PASS UPON HIS COMPETENCE. IT SHALL ISSUE A "TREE EXPERT" LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT, WHO:

- (1) PAYS THE FEE PROVIDED IN §5-419; (2) HAS
