ATTAINED HIS FIGHTEENTH BIRTHDAY; (3) HAS HAD FOUR YEARS OF APPROVED COLLEGE EDUCATION, PREFERABLY IN FORESTRY, LANDSCAPING, AGRICULTURE, OR THE EQUIVALENT; OR HAS HAD SUFFICIENT PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE IN TREE CARE TO JUSTIFY WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT OF FOUR YEARS OF COLLEGE OF AN EQUIVALENT EDUCATION; OR FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF HIS APPLICATION BEEN ENGAGED CONTINUOUSLY IN PRACTICE AS A TREE EXPERT; AND (4) HAS PASSED THE EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE DEPARTMENT.

paragraphs (2) and (4) are proposed for deletion by action of the Legislative Council. Paragraph (2) is not considered desirable from a policy standpoint and because it is inconsistent with other licensed professions open to persons who are not citizens. Paragraph (4) is nebulous in terms of standards and application. The only other changes made are in style.

(B) LICENSEE TO CARRY INSURANCE.—EVERY LICENSEE SHALL CARRY AND SHOW PROOF OF LIABILITY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE, IN THE FORM AND AMOUNT REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT AT THE TIME IT ISSUES THE LICENSE. THE LICENSEE SHALL MAINTAIN THE INSURANCE PROTECTION FOR THE PERIOD THE LICENSE IS IN EFFECT.
