

ACTIVITIES TO THE SECRETARY;

(6) ASSIST THE STATE EXTENSION FORESTER IN CARRYING OUT THE FARM FORESTRY EXTENSION PROGRAM;

(7) ASSIST FOREST LANDOWNERS IN FORMATION AND EXECUTION OF SCIL CONSERVATION PRACTICES;

(8) KEEP ACCURATE RECORDS OF ANY FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN;

(9) ASSIST IN MANAGEMENT OF COMMUNITY OR MUNICIPALLY OWNED FORESTS;

(10) ASSIST ASSESSORS IN APPRAISAL OF WOODLANDS;
AND

(11) ADVISE AND ASSIST IN PLANTING FOOD BEARING TREES AND SHRUBS FOR THE BENEFIT OF WILDLIFE.

5-608. LICENSE FOR FOREST PRODUCTS BUSINESS; REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES.

(A) LICENSE REQUIRED.—ANY PERSON ENGAGED IN A FOREST PRODUCTS BUSINESS SHALL HAVE A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE LICENSE IS SECURED FROM THE DEPARTMENT FOR EVERY TYPE OF FOREST PRODUCTS MANUFACTURING PLANT. BEFORE ANY SAWMILL OR OTHER PLANT IS ERECTED FOR THE MANUFACTURE OF LUMBER OR OTHER FOREST PRODUCTS OR WHEN THE LOCATION OF ANY MANUFACTURING PLANT IS TO BE CHANGED, THE LOCATION SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO ERECTION OF THE PLANT OR THE CHANGE OF LOCATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as the first paragraph of Article 66C, section 396 of the Code. The final sentence has been proposed for deletion as obsolete. The only other changes made are in style.

(B) REQUIREMENTS.—EACH PERSON TO WHOM THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES SHALL:

(1) LEAVE CONDITIONS FAVORABLE FOR REGROWTH. ANY FOREST LAND ON WHICH CUTTINGS ARE MADE SHALL BE LEFT BY THE OPERATOR IN A FAVORABLE CONDITION FOR
