(B) CRIERS.

A COURT CRIER SHALL RECEIVE THE PER DIEM COMPENSATION PROVIDED BY THIS SECTION FOR ATTENDING THE CIRCUIT COURT:

(1) CAROLINE - \$10;

(2) CECIL - AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS;

(3) KENT - \$10;

(4) QUEEN ANNE'S \$10;

(5) SOMERSET - AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS;

(6) TALBOT - AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS;

(7) WICOMICO - AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (b) is derived from Art. 36, §11(b). The section has been drafted to reflect actual practice. Provisions relating to counties which have abolished the office of crier have been deleted. If a county which does not presently use crier wishes to employ a crier, §2-501 of this article provides authority for doing so.

SUBTITLE 6. OFFICERS OF THE DISTRICT COURT.

SEC. 2-601. CHIEF CLERK; CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE CLERKS.

(A) THERE SHALL BE A CHIEF CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT, A CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE CLERK IN EACH DISTRICT, A CLERK IN EACH COUNTY, AND OTHER CLERICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES NECESSARY TO CONDUCT THE BUSINESS OF THE COURT.

(B) APPOINTMENT AND EMPLOYMENT.
