

CONSERVATION FUND TO THE STATE BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, BUREAU OF OUTDOOR RECREATION.

(D) "GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PARKS OF A LOCAL GOVERNING BODY WHICH CURRENTLY PROVIDES OR IS CHARGED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY WITH PROVIDING PUBLIC OUTDOOR RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE AREAS.

(E) "LOCAL GOVERNING BODY" MEANS THE MARYLAND NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION AND THE GOVERNING BODY OF ANY COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY.

(F) "LOCAL PROJECTS" MEANS ACQUISITION OR DEVELOPMENT OF PROJECTS SPONSORED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODIES OR THEIR UNITS, AND IN THE CASE OF BALTIMORE CITY IT ALSO MEANS OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PROJECTS AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (I) OF THIS SECTION.

(G) "MUNICIPAL CORPORATION" MEANS THE INCORPORATED TOWNS OF THE STATE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 11E OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.

(H) "SUBDIVISION" MEANS ONE OF THE 23 COUNTIES OF THE STATE OR BALTIMORE CITY.

[[(5) FOR BALTIMORE CITY AND FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 1973 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1975, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PROJECTS FINANCED UNDER PROGRAM OPEN SPACE, IF THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS EXPENDED DOES NOT EXCEED THE PROPORTION OF THE ALLOCATION TO BALTIMORE CITY WHICH IS DERIVED FROM CURRENT REVENUES, AS DISTINGUISHED FROM PROCEEDS OF BOND ISSUES.]]

(I) "TOTAL PROJECT COST" MEANS EVERY DIRECT COST ATTRIBUTABLE TO A PARTICULAR PROJECT, INCLUDING THE COST OF:

- (1) MATERIALS;
- (2) EQUIPMENT;
- (3) OTHER CAPITAL EXPENDITURES;
- (4) ACQUISITION OF LAND INCLUDING ANY INCIDENTAL COST RELATING TO ACQUISITION OF INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY, SUCH AS THE COST OF SURVEYS, APPRAISALS, TITLE SEARCH, AND LEGAL FEES, IF THE TOTAL PROJECTS WHICH ARE REIMBURSED FOR INCIDENTAL COSTS ARE LIMITED TO THE FEE SCHEDULES APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF
