5-1002. GATHLAND STATE PARK.

GATHLAND STATE PARK, IN FREDERICK AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES, SHALL BE DEVELOPED BY THE STATE FOR PURPOSES OF PUBLIC EDUCATION AND RECREATION, AS FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE.

PEVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 66C, sections 410 (a), (b), and (c). Subsections (a) and (b) are proposed for deletion as obsolete because the park has already been purchased for the price indicated in the present law, according to the Land and Property Division of the Department of Natural Resources. The only other changes made are in style.

5-1003. STATE PARK EETWEEN BROOKLYN MUD FLATS AND LIBERTY RESERVOIR ON PATAPSCO RIVER.

THE LANDS BETWEEN THE MUD FLATS AT BROOKLYN LIBERTY RESERVOIR ON EITHER SIDE OF THE PATAPSCO THE RIVER, IN ANNE ARUNDEL, CARROLL, HOWARD, AND EALTIMORE COUNTIES, WITHIN A DISTANCE OF ONE MILE ON EITHER SIDE FROM THE MEDIAL LINE OF THE RIVER, OR EITHER OF ITS BRANCHES, HAVING BEEN PURCHASED BY THE STATE, SHALL BE HELD BY THE STATE AS A STATE PARK UNDER THE PROTECTION ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT WHICH EXERCISE THE SAME POWER OF MAKING PULES REGULATIONS AND MANAGING THE LAND AS ANY OTHER STATE PARK. THE TERRITORY ACQUIRED IS SUBJECT TO ALL THE PASSED LAWS ΒY THE LEGISLATURE NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION.
