SUBTITLE 11. PUBLIC RECREATION ON PRIVATE LAND.

5-1101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) GENERALLY.—IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "CHARGE" MEANS PRICE OR FEE ASKED FOR SERVICES, ENTERTAINMENT, RECREATION PERFORMED, OR PRODUCTS OFFERED FOR SALE ON LAND OR IN RETURN FOR INVITATION OR PERMISSION TO ENTER OR GO UPON LAND.

(C) "EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THE FOLLOWING: NATURE STUDY, FARM VISITATIONS FOR PURPOSES OF LEARNING ABOUT THE FARMING OPERATION, PRACTICE JUDGING OF LIVESTOCK, DAIRY CATTLE, POULTRY, OTHER ANIMALS, AGRONOMY CROPS, HORTICULTURAL CROPS, OR OTHER FARM PRODUCTS, ORGANIZED VISITS TO FARMS BY SCHOOL CHILDREN, 4-H CLUBS, FFA CLUBS AND OTHERS AS PART OF THEIR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS, AND VIEWING HISTORICAL, ARCHAEOLOGICAL, OR SCIENTIFIC SITES.

(D) "LAND" MEANS LAND, ROADS, WATER, WATERCOURSES, PRIVATE WAYS AND BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES,
