6-210. EFFECT ON OTHER LAWS RELATING TO UNDERGROUND STORAGE OF GAS OR POLLUTION OF UNDERGROUND WATERS.

6-301. DEFINITION.

"DEPARTMENT" MEANS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

6-303. RULES AND REGULATIONS; PROTECTING WATERS.
