LEAST FIVE YEARS PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE AS A HAS AT WORKING EMPLOYEE IN THE UNDERGROUND OPERATIONS OF COAL ΙN THIS STATE. HE SHALL HAVE PASSED FIRST-GRADE MINE FOREMAN EXAMINATION BEFORE EXAMINING BOARD AND OBTAINED A CERTIFICATE COMPETENCY. IN ADDITION, THE INSPECTOR SHALL SATISFY THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL THAT HE HAS THEORETICAL AND PRACTICAL KNOWLEDGE OF THE WORKING, VENTILATION, DRAINAGE, AND OPERATION OF BITUMINOUS COAL MINES AND OF ALL NOXIOUS AND EXPLOSIVE GASES FOUND IN THEM, MINING LAW OF THE STATE, AND IS ALSO SUITED FOR THE DUTIES REQUIRED BY THIS POSITION.

REVISCR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Article 66C, section 499 of the Code. The reference to the "State Commissioner of Personnel" is proposed for deletion in light of the creation of the "Secretary of the Department of Personnel" by Chapter 98, Acts of 1970. "Personal fitness is proposed for deletion because ability" duplicates the phrase "suited". In addition, the Legislative Council Joint Subcommittee has proposed that provision requiring a 85 percent passing grade he deleted. The subcommittee felt that such a specific grade is arbitrary and that only a certificate of competency need be required. The only other changes made are in style.

(C) ASSIGNMENT; DIVISION AND REDIVISION DISTRICTS; RESIDENCE; DEVOTION OF FULL TIME OF TO DUTIES .-- THE BUREAU SHALL ASSIGN AND REASSIGN THE DISTRICT MINE INSPECTOR TO OR FROM A PRESCRIBED INSPECTION TERRITORY AS NECESSARY. THE DISTRICTS. COVERING THE MINING AREA OF THE STATE, SHALL BE DIVIDED AND REDIVIDED, DEPENDING ON THE WORK LOAD OF EACH INSPECTOR. FACH INSPECTOR SHALL RESIDE HIS ASSIGNED INSPECTION TERRITORY. EACH INSPECTOR SHALL DEVOTE HIS ENTIRE TIME TO THE DUTIES OF THIS OFFICE, AND MAY NOT HAVE AN INTEREST, DIRECT OR INDIRECT, IN ANY MINING OPERATION OR MINING INVESTMENT IN THIS OR ANY CONTIGUOUS STATE.
