(H) "LAND" MEANS THE SURFACE OF THE LAND ON WHICH OPEN-PIT MINING IS CONDUCTED.

(I) "LAND AFFECTED" MEANS THE LAND FROM WHICH THE OVERBURDEN IS REMOVED AND THEN OCCUPIED BY THE SPOIL.

(J) "LANDOWNER" MEANS PERSON IN WHOM THE LEGAL TITLE TO THE LAND IS VESTED.

(K) "OPEN-PIT MINING" OR "STRIP MINING" MEANS THE MINING OR RECOVERY OF BITUMINOUS COAL BY REMOVING THE STRATA OR MATERIAL WHICH OVERLIES OR IS ABOVE THE COAL DEPOSIT OR SEAM IN ITS NATURAL CONDITION. IT INCLUDES AUGER MINING.
