

EXTENDING UPON TWO OR MORE CONTIGUOUS TRACTS OF LAND.

(M) "OPERATOR" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN OPEN-PIT MINING AS A PRINCIPAL AS DISTINGUISHED FROM AN AGENT OR INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR.

(N) "OVERBURDEN" MEANS THE STRATA OR MATERIAL OVERLYING A BITUMINOUS COAL DEPOSIT IN ITS NATURAL STATE. IT INCLUDES THE MATERIAL BEFORE OR AFTER ITS REMOVAL BY OPEN-PIT MINING.

(O) "PLAN" OR "RECLAMATION PLAN" MEANS MINING AND RECLAMATION PLAN.
