

(F) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL NOT INSTITUTE ANY ACTION FOR AN INJUNCTION WHERE, PRIOR TO OR WITHIN FIFTEEN DAYS OF THE RECEIPT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S NOTICE, THE PERSON ALLEGED TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE SOUGHT AN ADVISORY OPINION FROM THE FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE ADVISORY BOARD WITH RESPECT TO SUCH MATTER AND, THEREAFTER, WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE BOARD'S ADVISORY OPINION, COMPLIED IN FULL THEREWITH."
