

(2) A RULE, REGULATION, OR BY-LAW OF AN AGENCY SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ART. 41, SEC. 9 OF THE CODE SHALL BE JUDICIALLY NOTICED OR READ IN EVIDENCE FROM THE PRINTED VOLUMES OR THE COPY FILED IN THE COURT OF APPEALS IF THE AGENCY HAS COMPLIED WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ART. 41, SEC. 9."
