

(C) SECRETARY AND DEPUTY SECRETARY OF A PRINCIPAL EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT OF STATE GOVERNMENT; AND

(D) APPOINTED OFFICIALS OF ANY LICENSING OR REGULATORY BOARD OF THE STATE OR ANY COUNTY GOVERNMENT IN THIS STATE, OR ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THIS STATE.”

Which amendment was read and adopted.

Amendment No. 4—

In line 19 on page 3 of the printed bill, strike out “in Maryland except his primary residence”.

Which amendment was read and adopted.

Amendment No. 5—

In line 25 on page 3 of the printed bill strike out beginning with “other” down to and including “institution” in line 27 and insert a comma after “monies”.

Which amendment was read and adopted.

Amendment No. 6—

In line 32 on page 3 of the printed bill strike out “employee,”.

Which amendment was read and adopted.

Amendment No. 7—

Delete their entireties lines 38 through 43 inclusive on page 3 of the printed bill and insert in lieu thereof the following:

“(5) A LIST OF BUSINESSES OF WHICH HE EXERCISES ANY FINANCIAL OR OTHER CONTROL THAT DO BUSINESS WITH THE STATE OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT; AND”

Which amendment was read and adopted.

Amendment No. 8—

Strike out in their entireties lines 44 and 45 on page 3 and lines 1 through 6 inclusive on page 4 of the printed bill and insert in lieu thereof the following:

“(6) IF THE INDIVIDUAL FILING ACTS IN A REPRESENTATIVE CAPACITY WITH ANY STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR OFFICER EXCEPT IN A MATTER BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR THE WORKMAN’S COMPENSATION COMMISSION AND RECEIVES A FEE IN EXCESS OF \$1,000 FOR THAT MATTER, A LIST OF ALL SUCH MATTERS INCLUDING THE NAME OF THE PERSON REPRESENTED, THE CATEGORY OF THE AMOUNT OF EACH FEE, AND A DESCRIPTION OF THE MATTER INVOLVED.”

Which amendment was read and adopted.
