

SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF [[THE STATE FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE LAW]] SECTIONS 29-1 TO 29-11 OF ARTICLE 33 OF THE CODE.

16. UNITS OF STATE GOVERNMENT TO SUPPLY STAFF AND ASSISTANCE.

EVERY UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT, WITHIN THE UNIT'S AREA OF KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERTISE, SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE BOARD AND MAY PROVIDE IT WITH ADDITIONAL TECHNICAL STAFF ASSISTANCE, FACILITIES, DATA AND INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR THE BOARD TO PERFORM ITS DUTIES.

17. COOPERATION AND ASSISTANCE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS WITH BOARD.

IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS RESPONSIBILITIES AS IT RELATES TO LAND USE, DEVELOPMENT, OR CONSTRUCTION, EVERY UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UPON REQUEST OF THE BOARD SHALL MAKE WHATEVER INFORMATION IT HAS AVAILABLE TO THE BOARD AS TO MATTERS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION AND CONCERN OF THE BOARD, AND SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL LAWFUL REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE BOARD TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE.

18. POWERS AND DUTIES OF BOARD IN GENERAL.

(A) THE BOARD, IN PERFORMANCE OF ITS DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS ARTICLE, MAY:

(1) FORMULATE POLICIES AND RECOMMENDATIONS RELATING TO THE GENERAL USE OR [[,]] DEVELOPMENT OF, OR CONSTRUCTION ON, LAND DESIGNATED AS PART OF AN AREA OF CRITICAL STATE CONCERN AND TO COORDINATE, IMPLEMENT, AND ADMINISTER SUCH POLICIES IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS;

(2) PARTICIPATE IN AND FURTHER EFFORTS RELATING TO LAND RESOURCES AND USES AMONG FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT;

(3) IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER PROGRAMS IN SUPPORT OF ITS POLICIES AND RECOMMENDATIONS;

(4) ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING ANY MATTER WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION;

(5) ARRANGE, CONDUCT OR SPONSOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND PROVIDE INFORMATION, CONCERNING LAND USE, DEVELOPMENT OR CONSTRUCTION, AND THE NEED FOR COORDINATED PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF;

(6) CREATE ADVISORY COMMITTEES, EITHER STATE, REGIONAL OR LOCAL IN CHARACTER, WHICH THE BOARD [[DEEM]]
