

## Article 66-1/2 - Vehicle Laws

6-406.1

NO [[POINTS SHALL BE ASSESSED]] VIOLATION SHALL BE RECORDED, EXCEPT FOR THE USE OF THE ADMINISTRATOR, AGAINST THE OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE FOR A VIOLATION OF THE VEHICLE LAWS CONCERNING IMPROPER OR FAULTY EQUIPMENT OR IMPROPER SIZE OR LOAD, WHEN THAT OPERATOR IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICLE'S OWNER [[THAT OPERATOR IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICLE'S OWNER AND]] [[THE VEHICLE WAS OPERATED IN AN OTHERWISE REASONABLE AND PRUDENT MANNER AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION]].

NO PENALTY SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON THE OPERATOR OF A VEHICLE FOR A VIOLATION OF THE VEHICLE LAWS CONCERNING IMPROPER OR FAULTY EQUIPMENT OR IMPROPER SIZE, WEIGHT OR LOAD, WHEN THAT OPERATOR IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICLE'S OWNER AND THE VEHICLE WAS OPERATED IN AN OTHERWISE REASONABLE AND PRUDENT MANNER AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION. ]]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
