

LOCATION WITHIN THE INSTITUTION WHEREIN SUCH PROPERTY WAS INITIALLY FOUND.

(B) PERSONAL PROPERTY BEING HELD BY THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION, IF CLAIMED WITHIN THE PERIOD OF TIME REFERRED TO IN SUBSECTION (A), SHALL BE DELIVERED TO THE INMATE WHO SATISFACTORILY ESTABLISHES A RIGHT TO ITS POSSESSION AND GIVES A PROPER RECEIPT THEREFOR.

(C) PERSONAL PROPERTY UNCLAIMED WITHIN THE PERIOD OF TIME REFERRED TO IN SUBSECTION (A) SHALL BE DEEMED ABANDONED. SUCH PROPERTY MAY THEN BE CONVERTED TO USE, SOLD, OR OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF ACCORDING TO PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION AND ALL FUTURE CLAIMS TO PROCEEDS OR RIGHTS TO POSSESSION SHALL BE ABSOLUTELY BARRED.

(D) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO CREATE OR RECOGNIZE ANY CAUSE, ACTION, OR DEFENSE, OR TO ABRIDGE ANY IMMUNITY NOW OR HEREAFTER HELD BY THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION, THE COMMISSIONER, OR ANY EMPLOYEE, AND NOTHING SHALL AFFECT OR LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF THE VARIOUS INSTITUTIONS TO SEIZE AND DISPOSE OF CONTRABAND IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAWS RELATING THERETO.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 350

(Senate Bill 514)

AN ACT concerning

Water Resources - Well Drilling and Well Drillers

FOR the purpose of amending and adding to the definitions generally relating to wells, the business of well drilling, and well drillers; expanding the provisions relating to well drillers to include drive-point wells and hand-dug wells; authorizing the Board of Well Drillers to issue journeymen's licenses; modifying the well driller's application and license fee structure; and generally relating to wells, well drillers, the business of well drilling and the Board of Well Drillers.
