

THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE SHALL BE DISPLAYED UPON DEMAND OF ANY OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION OR ANY STATE OR LOCAL OFFICER CHARGED WITH ENFORCEMENT OF STATE LAWS. NO AIRCRAFT SHALL BE ISSUED A STATE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE THAT DOES NOT HAVE AN APPROPRIATE AND CURRENTLY EFFECTIVE REGISTRATION AND AIRWORTHINESS CERTIFICATE AS ISSUED BY THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION OR SIMILAR FEDERAL AUTHORITY. ANY AIRCRAFT OWNED BY A PERSON RESIDENT IN THIS STATE WHICH IS BASED OR HANGARED IN ANOTHER STATE SHALL BE EXEMPTED FROM REGISTRATION, PROVIDED THAT THE AIRCRAFT IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REGISTRATION LAWS OF THAT STATE, IF ANY. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, AIRCRAFT SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE PERMANENTLY BASED OR HANGARED IN THIS STATE, IF BASED OR HANGARED IN THIS STATE FOR MORE THAN 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS OR FOR ANY 60 DAYS ANNUALLY. ALL AIRCRAFT ENGAGED IN DUSTING OR SPRAYING WITHIN THIS STATE (REGARDLESS OF THEIR SITUS OR BASE) ARE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED.

(2) ALL AIRPORT OPERATORS ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP REASONABLE RECORDS IN THE COURSE OF THEIR BUSINESS, SHOWING ALL AIRCRAFT BASED OR HANGARED AT THEIR AIRPORTS. SUCH RECORDS SHALL INCLUDE THE "N" NUMBER, TYPE AND MODEL OF THE AIRCRAFT, ITS OWNER OR OPERATOR AND HIS ADDRESS, THE NUMBER OF DAYS THE AIRCRAFT WAS SO BASED OR HANGARED [[AND THE MARYLAND REGISTRATION NUMBER AND, IN ITS ABSENCE, THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF THAT STATE IN WHICH THE AIRCRAFT IS REGISTERED]]. ALL AIRPORT OPERATORS SHALL SUBMIT SUCH RECORDS TO THE ADMINISTRATION, TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS[, AND TO ANY COURT UPON REQUEST]].

(B) APPLICATIONS FOR THE REGISTRATION OF AIRCRAFT SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A SWORN STATEMENT CONTAINING ALL OF THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION FOR SUCH REGISTRATION.

REGISTRATION FEES SHALL BE PAYABLE ANNUALLY ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, AND REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES FOR PART OF A YEAR ISSUED AFTER THE FIRST DAY OF THE FOLLOWING JULY SHALL BE ISSUED AT THE RATE OF FIFTY (50) PER CENTUM OF THE ANNUAL FEE. THE FEE SHALL BE COMPUTED AT THE RATE OF ONE AND ONE-HALF CENTS (1 1/2¢) PER POUND OF MANUFACTURER'S GROSS WEIGHT FOR THE AIRCRAFT BEING REGISTERED; EXCEPT THAT THE ANNUAL FEE FOR ANY AIRCRAFT SHALL BE NOT LESS THAN TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

(C) WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER THE SALE OF A REGISTERED AIRCRAFT, THE PURCHASER THEREOF SHALL RETURN TO THE ADMINISTRATION THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE OF SUCH AIRCRAFT, TOGETHER WITH THE DATE AND PLACE OF SALE OR TRANSFER, AND HIS NAME AND ADDRESS OR RESIDENCE, AND SHALL SIMULTANEOUSLY APPLY FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE.
