

(1) ANY AIRCRAFT OWNED BY A STATE OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THEREOF, OR ANY AIRCRAFT OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

(2) MILITARY AIRCRAFT OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT OR ANY AIRCRAFT LICENSED BY A FOREIGN COUNTRY WITH WHICH THE UNITED STATES HAS RECIPROCAL RELATIONS; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH AIRCRAFT SHALL NOT BE ENGAGED IN ANY COMMERCIAL ACTIVITY WITHIN THIS STATE.

(3) ANY AIRCRAFT OWNED OR OPERATED BY AN AIR CARRIER CERTIFIED BY OR OPERATING PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION AUTHORITY FROM THE CIVIL AERONAUTICS BOARD FOR CARRYING OF PASSENGERS, CARGO OR MAIL IN INTERSTATE OR FOREIGN COMMERCE.

(4) AIRCRAFT OWNED BY RESIDENTS OF MINERAL COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA AND BASED IN ALLEGANY COUNTY, MARYLAND, PROVIDED THAT AIRCRAFT OWNED BY RESIDENTS OF ALLEGANY COUNTY, MARYLAND AND BASED IN MINERAL COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA ARE EXEMPTED FROM PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES IMPOSED BY MINERAL COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA.

(5) AIRCRAFT OWNED BY PERSONS IN MILITARY SERVICE WHO ARE NONRESIDENTS OF THIS STATE BUT WHO, BY VIRTUE OF THEIR ORDERS, HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO DUTY IN THIS STATE. THIS EXEMPTION APPLIES ONLY SO LONG AS THESE PERSONS[[,]] REMAIN NONRESIDENTS OF THIS STATE AND THEIR AIRCRAFT [[IS]] ARE REGISTERED BY THE STATE OF THEIR RESIDENCE.

(H) (1) ANY AIRCRAFT FOUND OPERATING IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND IN VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION MAY BE SEIZED AND HELD BY THE STATE AVIATION ADMINISTRATION OR THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE UNTIL THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION HAVE BEEN COMPLIED WITH, AND THE PERSON OR PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR SUCH ILLEGAL OPERATION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES PRESCRIBED BY SUBSECTION (2).

(2) ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE REGISTRATION PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OR NOT MORE THAN \$500.00 OR BY IMPRISONMENT OF NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS, OR BOTH, IN THE DISCRETION OF THE COURT.

(A) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, EVERY INDIVIDUAL WHO PILOTS AN AIRCRAFT WITHIN THIS STATE SHALL REGISTER AS REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION. A REGISTERED PILOT SHALL NOTIFY THE ADMINISTRATION OF ANY CHANGE OF ADDRESS WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE CHANGE. EVERY PILOT SHALL HAVE HIS STATE
