(Senate Bill 781)

AN ACT concerning

Elections - Precinct Registers

FOR the purpose of permitting the local boards of election, under certain circumstances, to use precinct registers consisting of an alphabetical compilation of registered voters electronically reproduced through data processing; correcting certain language; and generally relating to the registration of voters, permanent and temporary certificates of registration, and procedures related thereto and to records of persons voting.
