- (2) Practice nursing as defined by this subtitle under color of any diploma, license, or record illegally or fraudulently obtained or signed or issued unlawfully or under fraudulent representation.
- (3) Practice [professional nursing] AS A REGISTERED NURSE or A LICENSED practical [nursing] NURSE as defined by this subtitle unless [duly] licensed to do so under the provisions of this subtitle.
- (4) Use in connection with his or her name the designation "nurse" [(except as authorized in § 300 (e) of this article)] or any other designation tending to imply that he or she is a licensed registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse unless [duly] licensed so to practice under the provisions of this subtitle; provided, however, that until June 1, 1969, nothing in this subtitle shall prevent unlicensed persons from using the designation "nurse" or "practical nurse."].
- (5) Practice [professional nursing] AS A REGISTERED NURSE or A LICENSED practical [nursing] NURSE during the time his or her license issued under the provisions of this subtitle [shall be] HAS lapsed, OR BEEN suspended or revoked.
- (6) KNOWINGLY EMPLOY UNLICENSED PERSONS IN THE PRACTICE OF BURSING.
- (7) FAIL TO REPORT TO THE BOARD AT LEAST ANNUALLY THE NAMES OF ALL PERSONS EMPLOYED BY THEM FOR THE PRACTICE OF NURSING.
- (b) Any person, INSTITUTION OR AGENCY convicted of violating this subtitle shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars for the first offense. Each subsequent offense [shall be] IS punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment of not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.]]

This subtitle shall be known and may be cited as the ["Nurses Licensing] "NURSE PRACTICE Act."

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
