4-710.

(c) A person may not fish with any net whose size of stretched mesh, allowing a reasonable tolerance for shrinkage, is less than the following: pound net, [2 1/4] 1 1/2 inches; haul seine, 2 1/2 inches; gill net, 2 1/2 inches; fyke or hoop net, 2 1/4 inches. This subsection does not apply to catching eels with a net.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 398

(Senate Bill 945)

AN ACT concerning

[[Baltimore City]] - Alcoholic Beverages
