

be appropriate to promote and attain the purposes set forth in its charter.

(14) TO BE A PROMOTER, PARTNER, MEMBER, ASSOCIATE, OR MANAGER OF ANY PARTNERSHIP, JOINT VENTURE, TRUST OR OTHER ENTERPRISE.

(b) It shall not be necessary to set forth in the charter the powers enumerated in this section, but any corporation may by its charter specifically limit or prohibit the corporation from exercising any of said enumerated powers.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 402

(Senate Bill 1020)

AN ACT concerning

Financial Disclosure

FOR the purpose of providing that candidates for nomination for, or election to, orphans' court judgeships, shall file their financial statements with local boards of election supervisors rather than the State Administrative Board of Elections.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 29-9(b) of Article 33 - Election Code, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code
