appointed to a term which expires June 1, 1975, and one member shall be appointed to a term which expires June 1, 1976. One member shall be designated by the Governor as chairman. IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY A MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL REMAIN IN OFFICE UNTIL A REPLACEMENT IS APPOINTED, AND THE SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED NEW MEMBERS SHALL BE DONE THREE MONTHS BEFORE THE TERM BEGINS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act [[shall take effect July 1, 1974.]] is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
