[shall have] transferred, for the purposes of establishing compensation rates and the basic rates for vacation and sick leave credit earnings.

(B) WITH RESPECT TO VACATION AND SICK LEAVE CREDIT EARNINGS, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION APPLY TO ALL PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL EMPLOYED BY THE MARYLAND STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION PRIOR TO JULY 1, 1972.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

## CHAPTER 425

(House Bill 218)

AN ACT concerning

Pistol and Revolver Dealer's License - Fees
