

of each year thereafter. The initial fee for [such] THE license shall be [twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)] FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00), and the annual renewal shall be [five dollars (\$5.00)] [[TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00)]] TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00), payable to the Comptroller of the State of Maryland. [Such licenses] THE LICENSE shall not be transferable [[not]] nor shall any refund or proration of the annual fee therefor be allowed. Provided, however, that before any licensee changes his place of business he shall so inform the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police or his duly authorized agent or agents and surrender his license, whereupon the [said] Superintendent or his duly authorized agent or agents shall, if no cause exists for the revocation of [such] THE license, issue a new license, without fee, covering the new place of business for the duration of the unexpired term of the surrendered license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 61 and 68 of Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
