3-205.

The trustees may appoint a Director of the Trust to administer its activities subject to the Trustees' supervision. They may employ other persons as necessary. The director and staff are employees of the [Trust and not the] State, BUT THE DIRECTOR SHALL NOT BE A [[MEMBERS]] MEMBER OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE. The Trustees may remove the Director [[and any other employee]] at their will.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 436

(House Bill 261)

AN ACT concerning

Secretary of Natural Resources - Appointment of Staff Assistants
