(E) A PERSON WHO DISCLOSES THE CONTENTS OF ANY GRAND JURY PROCEEDING, EXCEPT FOR PERSONS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO MAKE SUCH DISCLOSURES, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN ONE YEAR, OR BOTH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

## CHAPTER 465

(House Bill 782)

AN ACT concerning

Abandoned Vehicles - Scrap Processors

FOR the purpose of protecting <u>certain</u> scrap processors who destroy certain abandoned motor vehicles by authorizing them to file an indemnity agreement with the Motor Vehicle Administration and relating generally to disposition of abandoned motor vehicles.
