CHAPTER 485

(House Bill 970)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland [[Environmental]] Historical Trust

FOR the purpose of establishing an official Inventory of Historic Sites, stating its purpose and to whom it is available, designating the Keeper of the Inventory of Historic Sites, stating the Keeper's duties, establishing a Landmark List, designating what properties are landmarks, designating the Keeper of the Landmark List, and stating the Keeper's duties.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 181KA be and it is hereby added to Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) to read as follows:
