Article 2B — Alcoholic Beverages Section 104 Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 104 of Article 2B — Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re—enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

104.

In St. Mary's County, notwithstanding any other provision of this article, the hours during which a liquor licensee may sell those alcoholic beverages for which he is licensed shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. the following morning, including Sunday. [Consumption of alcoholic beverages may continue on the premises of the establishment for one—half hour following the termination of the hours of sale only on Sunday.] NO CONSUMER MAY REMAIN ON THE PREMISES OF THE ESTABLISHMENT AFTER THE TERMINATION OF THE HOURS OF SALE, EXCEPT THAT CUSTOMERS MAY REMAIN ON THE PREMISES FOR ONE—HALF HOUR AFTER THE CLOSING TIME ON SUNDAY MORNING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
