- (3) DATE AND PLACE OF BIRTH OF DECEASED.
- (4) DATE AND PLACE OF DEATH OF DECEASED.
- (5) FULL NAMES AND PLACES OF BIRTH OF DECEDENT'S PARENTS.
 - (6) PLACE OF INTERMENT OR CREMATION OF DECEDENT.
 - (7) OCCUPATION OF DECEDENT.
 - (8) NAME AND RELATIONSHIP OF INFORMANT.
- (9) ANY OTHER INFORMATION DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE TO BE NONCONFIDENTIAL.

THE SAME DATA MAY BE EXTRACTED FROM ANY DEATH CERTIFICATES IN THE CUSTODY OF THE HALL OF RECORDS. COSTS INCURRED IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE BORNE BY THE HALL OF RECORDS THE DATA MADE AVAILABLE TO RESEARCHERS DOES COMMISSION. CONSTITUTE OFFICIAL RECORDS. AND THE USE AND PUBLICATION OF SUCH EXTRACTED DATA DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE. USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC COPIES OF CERTIFICATES BY PERSONNEL OF THE HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION IN PREPARING DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE. THIS DATA MAY NOT BE SUPPLIED TO ANY PERSON FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 575

(House Bill 1561)

AN ACT concerning

Worcester County Crabs - Landing in the State

FOR the purpose of requiring any crabs caught in the waters of [[the State]] Worcester County to be landed in the State, and providing that the Department of Natural Resources may waive the provisions of this Act under certain circumstances, and making this Act an emergency measure.
