

(1) EVERY EXECUTIVE ORDER THAT IS GENERALLY PERMANENT IN NATURE;

(2) EVERY ADMINISTRATIVE RULE ADOPTED BY ANY AGENCY PURSUANT TO THE PROCEDURES OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT;

(3) EVERY DOCUMENT OR CLASS OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO BE PUBLISHED IN THE AGENCY RULES BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND

(4) ANY OTHER DOCUMENT OR CLASS OF DOCUMENTS WHICH THE AELR COMMITTEE REQUIRES OR PERMITS TO BE PUBLISHED UNLESS OTHERWISE PRIVILEGED.

(C) ANNOTATIONS.

THE ADMINISTRATOR MAY PREPARE, OR PROCURE BY CONTRACT, AND INCLUDE IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS ANNOTATIONS OF JUDICIAL DECISIONS AND OTHER EXPLANATORY MATERIAL RELATING TO ANY DOCUMENT PUBLISHED IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS.

256D. DEPOSIT OF DOCUMENTS.

[[ (A) TRANSFER FROM SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE.

WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER TO THE ADMINISTRATOR ALL MATERIAL AND DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS THAT ARE IN HIS OFFICE.

(B) FILING WITH DIVISION. ]]

ANY DOCUMENT REQUIRED OR PERMITTED TO BE PUBLISHED IN THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS OR MARYLAND REGISTER SHALL BE FILED WITH THE DIVISION OF STATE DOCUMENTS. IF A DOCUMENT HAS BEEN FORWARDED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, IT NEED NOT BE FILED WITH THE DIVISION OF STATE DOCUMENTS, UNLESS THE ADMINISTRATOR OTHERWISE NOTIFIES THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR FILING THE [[ DOCUMENTS ]] DOCUMENT.

256E. PUBLICATION.

THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE PROMPT PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 256L.

256F. TEMPORARY SUPPLEMENTS TO OFFICIAL CODIFICATION.
