publication of the compilation shall be printed in full in a supplement to the codification or in any subsequent compilation of the rules and regulations.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

## CHAPTER 601

(Senate Bill 174)

AN ACT concerning

[[Physically Handicapped Persons - Employment]]

Human Relations Commission Physically or Mentally Handicapped Persons

FOR the purpose of providing that it is unlawful for certain persons and organizations to discriminate in certain employment practices against persons who are mentally or physically handicapped; making certain exceptions thereto; prohibiting certain discriminatory activities against the physically or mentally handicapped in housing [[or obtaining loans on dwellings]]; and making technical corrections to the language of existing provisions of the Code.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

Article 49B - Human Relations Commission Section 19, 21(a)[[, 22 and 23(a)]] and 22 Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That [[Section]] Sections 19, 21(a)[[, 22 and 23(a)]] and 22 of Article 49B — Human Relations Commission, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re—enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 49B - Human Relations Commission
