

PREVIOUS TIME SERVED AS A FULL-TIME PAID EMPLOYEE OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THIS STATE AND WHO IS NOT ENTITLED TO RECEIVE SERVICE CREDIT FOR THE SAME PERIOD UNDER ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, OR WHO IS NOT RECEIVING RETIREMENT BENEFITS FROM ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THIS STATE, SHALL BE ENTITLED TO CREDIT FOR PREVIOUS SERVICE RENDERED BY HIM TO THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION UPON MAKING IN A SINGLE PAYMENT, WITHIN WHATEVER PERIOD OF TIME AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, THE CONTRIBUTIONS WITH INTEREST, WHICH HE WOULD HAVE PAID ON BEHALF OF THAT SERVICE. UPON RECEIVING A CLAIM FOR THAT SERVICE CREDIT FROM THE EMPLOYEE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL VERIFY THE FACT OF THE SERVICE CREDIT AND THE COMPENSATION RECEIVED, AND SHALL DETERMINE THE AMOUNT DUE FOR THE SERVICE BASED ON THE CONTRIBUTIONS, WITH INTEREST, WHICH HE WOULD HAVE PAID HAD HE BEEN A MEMBER OF THIS SYSTEM DURING THAT PERIOD OF SERVICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 615

(Senate Bill 437)

AN ACT concerning

Chartered Counties - Express Powers

FOR the purpose of including among the express powers of chartered counties of Maryland, the power to provide financial support for artistic, musical and cultural public and private non-profit organizations and activities.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

Article 25A - Chartered Counties of Maryland
