If any registrant fails to renew his certificate within the twelve-month period provided above, and later applies for renewal, he may be required to present reasons for said renewal. The Board, at its discretion, may grant a renewal of such certificate, in which case the renewal fee shall be the same as the registration fee for professional engineers and for professional land surveyors, and for property line surveyors or may require reapplication.

[(g)] (F) Should the Board deny the issuance of a certificate of registration to any applicant, the initial fee deposited shall be retained as an application fee.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
