October 21 of each year.

- (1) In Kent and Queen Anne's counties only a riparian owner owning the required amount of shoreline, his lessee, licensee, or assignee, may erect and maintain stationary blind or blind site, if he applies before October 11 of each year.
- A RESIDENT WHO APPLIES FOR A LICENSE STATIONARY BLIND OR BLIND SITE IN THE WATER [[IN FRONT OF]] ADJACENT TO BLOODSWORTH ISLAND IN DORCHESTER COUNTY IS NOT REQUIRED TO OBTAIN WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE RIPARIAN OWNER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
