## (Senate Bill 701)

AN ACT concerning

Hospital Care Costs for Indigent and Medically Indigent Persons and Declaration of Estimated Income Tax

FOR the purpose of [[eliminating]] reducing the payments by the counties and Baltimore City toward hospital care costs for indigent and medically indigent persons for the fiscal year 1975 and thereafter, changing the date on or before which an amended declaration of estimated income tax is required to be filed and one-fourth of the estimated tax due required to be paid, providing for an appropriation for the 1974-1975 fiscal year of the funds necessary for the increase in State payments for the Medical Assistance Program and relating generally to reducing the payments by Baltimore City and the counties for the hospital care of indigent and medically indigent persons and increasing the State payments to the Medical Assistance Program through advancement of payment of a portion of estimated income tax.
