COUNTY, MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, OR BALTIMORE CITY IS AUTHORIZED TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR SUCH RELOCATION PROJECTS FROM ANY APPROPRIATE FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL FUNDS IT RECEIVES FOR THIS PURPOSE.

(E) THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7.03 OF THIS ARTICLE DO NOT APPLY TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

## CHAPTER 652

(Senate Bill 807)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Sabbath Breaking

FOR the purpose of exempting Dorchester County from the laws of the State relating to Sabbath Breaking, except those concerning alcoholic beverages, bowling alleys, tenpin alleys, duckpin alleys, or poolrooms; and making this Act subject to the outcome of a referendum.
