

SCHOOL TEACHING SERVICE UP TO A MAXIMUM OF TEN YEARS, PROVIDED HE SHALL FILE CLAIM THEREFOR WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND SHALL PAY INTO THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE RESERVES REQUIRED TO FUND THE ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE FOR SUCH YEARS OF OUT-OF-STATE [[AND/]]OR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING SERVICE AS HE MAY CLAIM. (14) ANY MEMBER WHO WAS FORMERLY EMPLOYED ON A TEMPORARY OR EMERGENCY BASIS WITH THE STATE OR A PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITY, MAY PURCHASE CREDIT FOR SUCH SERVICE UPON PAYMENT TO THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM, IN A SINGLE PAYMENT, WITH INTEREST TO DATE OF PAYMENT, THE CONTRIBUTIONS WHICH HE WOULD HAVE PAID HAD HE BEEN A MEMBER OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BUT WITHDREW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
