- (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO REGISTRANTS WHO PAY THEIR ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE BUT DO NOT PRACTICE IN MARYLAND DURING THE YEAR.
- (C) ANY INDIVIDUAL APPLYING FOR INITIAL REGISTRATION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE EXEMPTED FROM THIS REQUIREMENT, AND THE BOARD MAY, AT ITS DISCRETION, REGISTER ANY LICENSEE IF THE LICENSEE PROVES SUBSEQUENT COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

(Senate Bill 902)

. AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Revocation of Licenses, Point System

FOR the purpose of abolishing mandatory revocations of motor vehicle license for certain serious offenses and providing for a revision of the assessment of points under the point system and clarifying language.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 6-205 of Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed.
