DEPOSIT IN A BANK TO HIS A FIDUCIARY MAKES A ΙF PERSONAL CREDIT OF CHECKS DRAWN BY HIM UPON AN ACCOUNT IN HIS OWN NAME AS FIDUCIARY, OR OF CHECKS PAYABLE TO HIM AS FIDUCIARY, OR OF CHECKS DRAWN BY HIM UPON AN ACCOUNT NAME OF HIS PRINCIPAL IF HE IS EMPOWERED TO DRAW CHECKS THEREON, OR OF CHECKS PAYABLE TO HIS PRINCIPAL AND INDORSED BY HIM, IF HE IS EMPOWERED TO INDORSE THE CHECKS. OF IF HE OTHERWISE MAKES A DEPOSIT OF FUNDS HELD BY HIM AS FILUCIARY, THE EANK RECEIVING THE DEPOSIT EE BOUND TO INQUIRE WHETHER THE PIDUCIARY NOT BREACH COMMITTING THEREBY A OF HIS OBLIGATION FIDUCIARY: AND THE BANK IS AUTHORIZED TO PAY THE AMOUNT OF THE DEPOSIT OR ANY PART THEREOF UPON THE PERSONAL OF THE FIDUCIARY WITHOUT BEING CHECK LIABLE TO THE PRINCIPAL, UNIESS THE BANK RECEIVES THE DEPOSIT OR PAYS CHECK WITH ACTUAL KNOWLEDGE THAT THE FIDUCIARY IS COMMITTING A EREACH OF HIS OBLIGATION AS FICUCIARY IN MAKING THE DEPOSIT OR DRAWING THE CHECK, OR WITH KNOWLEDGE OF THE FACTS THAT ITS ACTION IN RECEIVING DEPOSIT OF PAYING THE CHECK AMOUNTS TO EAD FAITH.

15-209. CASES NOT PROVIDED FOR IN ARTICLE.

IN ANY CASE NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBTITLE THE RULES OF LAW AND EQUITY, INCLUDING THE LAW MERCHANT AND THOSE RULES OF LAW AND EQUITY RELATING TO TRUSTS, AGENCY, NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS, AND BANKING, SHALL CONTINUE TO APPLY.

15-210. UNIFORMITY OF INTERPRETATION.

THE MARYLAND UNIFORM FIDUCIARIES ACT SHALL BE SO INTERPRETED AND CONSTRUED AS TO EFFECTUATE ITS GENERAL PURPOSE TO MAKE UNIFORM THE LAW OF THOSE STATES WHICH ADOPT IT.

15-211. SHORT TITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE MARYLAND UNIFORM FIDUCIARIES ACT.

REVISCR'S NOTE: These sections presently appear as Art. 37A, §§1 through 2, 4 through 9, and 11 through 13. Sec. 10 has been omitted because it applies to transactions taking place prior to June 1, 1929 and it is no longer considered to be applicable.
