CHAPTER 694

(Senate Bill 1083)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Deer Hunting

FOR the purpose of regulating the hunting, pursuing and killing of deer of either sex in Dorchester County and placing a time limit upon the application of this regulation.

BY adding to

Article - Natural Resources  
Section 10-415.1  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1974 Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 10-415.1 be and it is hereby added to Article - Natural Resources, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume) to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-415.1. DEER HUNTING - DORCHESTER COUNTY.

(A) REGULATIONS FOR HUNTING DEER IN DORCHESTER COUNTY.

ANTLERLESS DEER IN PLACE OF ANTLERED DEER MAY BE HUNTED, PURSUED, OR KILLED ONLY BY SPECIAL PERMIT DURING THE FIREARMS SEASON, EXCEPT IN THAT PORTION OF DORCHESTER COUNTY LYING SOUTH AND WEST OF HIGHWAY U.S. ROUTE 50. TWO DEER OF EITHER SEX MAY BE TAKEN WITHOUT THE NEED FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT. NORTH AND EAST OF HIGHWAY U.S. ROUTE 50 IN DORCHESTER COUNTY ONE DEER OF EITHER SEX MAY BE TAKEN.
