public school employees[[.]]; limiting the number of negotiating units and providing recognition of employee organizations as exclusive representatives of such units; providing for procedures in the event of impasse; prohibiting strikes by such employees or employee organizations; and relating generally to the relationship between public school employers and non-certificated public school employees; and exempting Caroline, Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne's and Talbot Counties from the provisions of this Act.
