(House Bill 368)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Office of State's Attorney

FOR the purpose of increasing the salaries of the State's Attorney and deputy State's attorneys for Baltimore County, subject to certain constitutional restrictions, requiring their full-time employment and prohibiting their engaging in the private practice of law[, with certain exceptions for part-time deputy State's attorneys; increasing the number and salaries of assistant State's attorneys for Baltimore County; and providing that administrative and clerical employees in the Office of State's Attorney shall be under the Merit System of Baltimore County.] and specifying the number, salaries, and duties of certain assistant State's attorneys for Baltimore County.
