

providing miscellaneous rules relating to real property, providing for fees for recording real property instruments, providing for the collection of money received for actions related to the issuance of land patents, providing a bar to a claim derived from a land patent, providing a duty for the recipient of funds for tax purposes in behalf of a taxpayer to pay the tax, establishing an effective date and for the applicability of the Article, providing for a lien by the State on personal property, transferring the statute of frauds from Article 21 to a new Article 39C, repealing inconsistent laws, and generally relating these and all matters pertaining to real property.
