

CAMPAIGN DONATION OF THE MINIMUM AMOUNT DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION SHALL PRESENT AND HAVE CERTIFIED BY THE APPROPRIATE BOARD, SIGNATURES TOTALING NOT LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT OF ALL THE REGISTERED VOTERS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE FOR THE CANDIDATE. THE REQUIREMENT FOR RECEIVING THE MAXIMUM PUBLIC CAMPAIGN DONATION SHALL NOT REQUIRE SIGNATURES IN EXCESS OF 10 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL OF REGISTERED VOTERS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE FOR THAT OFFICE. BETWEEN THIS MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM SIGNATURE REQUIREMENT AND THE CORRESPONDING MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM DONATIONS TO BE GRANTED, THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH A REASONABLE NUMBER OF OTHER SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS AND CORRESPONDING DONATION AMOUNTS. THE COMMISSION SHALL PUBLICLY DECLARE THESE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND PROPORTIONATE DONATION AMOUNTS NO LATER THAN JANUARY 1 OF THE YEAR IN WHICH THE ELECTION IS TO BE HELD.

30-4. PETITIONS FOR PUBLIC CAMPAIGN DONATION.

(A) CONTENTS OF A PAPER.

A PETITION FOR A PUBLIC CAMPAIGN DONATION SHALL CONSIST OF A NUMBER OF PAPERS, EACH OF WHICH SHALL:

(1) STATE THE NAME OF THE CANDIDATE, THE OFFICE HE SEEKS, AND THE ELECTION AREA FROM WHICH HE MAY BE ELECTED;

(2) CONTAIN ONLY THE SIGNATURES OF REGISTERED VOTERS WHO RESIDE WITHIN THE AREA WHERE THE CANDIDATE IS STANDING FOR ELECTION;

(3) HAVE THE SIGNATURES IT CONTAINS ON SEPARATE PAPERS OF NOT MORE THAN 8 1/2 INCHES IN WIDTH OR 14 INCHES IN LENGTH, BEARING ONE OR MORE SIGNATURES, AND NOT MERELY APPENDED TO A SINGLE PAPER;

(4) CONTAIN ONLY THE NAMES OF PERSONS RESIDING IN A SINGLE COUNTY;

(5) STATE AFTER EVERY SIGNATURE THE ADDRESS OF THE SIGNER, THE PRECINCT AND ELECTION DISTRICT WHERE HE RESIDES, AND IMMEDIATELY BELOW THE SIGNATURE SHALL EITHER BE TYPED OR PRINTED THE NAME OF THE SIGNER;

(6) BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN AFFIDAVIT IN WHICH THE AFFIANT TAKES AN OATH THAT TO THE BEST OF HIS KNOWLEDGE THE SIGNERS ARE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE COUNTY STATED ON THE PAPER, THAT THE AFFIANT PERSONALLY SAW THE SIGNERS SIGN THE PAPER, AND THE AFFIDAVIT SHALL BE SWORN AND CERTIFIED BEFORE A NOTARY PUBLIC OR OTHER OFFICIAL AUTHORIZED TO TAKE OATHS IN THE STATE; AND

(7) CONTAIN A BLANK SPACE FOR ENDORSEMENT AS
