(12) ADOPT ANY PROCEDURE, RULE, OR REGULATION NECESSARY FOR THE EFFECTIVE ADMINISTRATION OF THIS SUBTITLE ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.

30-7. ALLOCATION OF FAIR CAMPAIGN FINANCING FUND.

(A) GENERAL ALLOCATION OF FUND.

THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE DIVISION OF MONEY IN THE FAIR CAMPAIGN FINANCING FUND AS FOLLOWS:

(1) 1/2 OF A PERCENT TO BE DISBURSED ONLY IN CASE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION;

(2) 66 PERCENT OF THE REMAINDER TO BE AVAILABLE ONLY FOR DISBURSEMENT IN A PRIMARY ELECTION; AND

(3) THE REMAINDER TO BE AVAILABLE ONLY FOR DISBURSEMENT IN A GENERAL ELECTION.

(B) ALLOCATION OF MONEY IN PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS.

THE COMMISSION SHALL FURTHER DIVIDE THE MONEY ALLOCATED TO THE PRIMARY OR GENERAL ELECTION CATEGORIES PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION AS FOLLOWS:

(1) 30 PERCENT TO BE AVAILABLE FOR STATE-WIDE ELECTIONS, TO INCLUDE CAMPAIGNS FOR UNITED STATES SENATE, GOVERNOR, AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, ATTORNEY GENERAL, AND COMPTROLLER;

(2) 23 PERCENT TO BE AVAILABLE FOR ELECTIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, TO INCLUDE CAMPAIGNS FOR THE STATE SENATE OR HOUSE OF DELEGATES;

(3) 22 PERCENT TO BE AVAILABLE FOR ELECTIONS TO COUNTY OFFICES, TO INCLUDE OFFICES TO BE FILLED BY COUNTY-WIDE OR COUNTY DISTRICT ELECTIONS;

(4) 20 PERCENT TO BE AVAILABLE FOR ELECTIONS TO BE HELD IN A CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT FOR THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES; AND

(5) 5 PERCENT TO BE AVAILABLE FOR ELECTIONS TO JUDICIAL OFFICES, TO INCLUDE OFFICES TO BE FILLED BY STATE-WIDE, COUNTY-WIDE, DISTRICT OR CIRCUIT ELECTIONS.

(C) FURTHER DIVISION OF THE FUND.
