VOTES RECEIVED BY ALL CANDIDATES IN THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR THAT OFFICE.

- (I) "MAXIMUM PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION" FOR ANY CANDIDATE IS AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 75 PERCENT OF THE CANDIDATE'S CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURE LIMIT IN THE GENERAL ELECTION, AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 30-3.
- (J) "MINOR PARTY" MBANS A POLITICAL PARTY WHOSE CANDIDATE FOR THE SAME OFFICE IN THE IMMEDIATE PREVIOUS ELECTION TO THAT FOR WHICH PUBLIC FINANCING IS CURRENTLY SOUGHT, RECEIVED LESS THAN 25 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL POPULAR VOTES RECEIVED BY ALL CANDIDATES IN THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR THAT OFFICE, OR HAS FILED A VALID PETITION FOR THE FORMATION OF A NEW POLITICAL PARTY PURSUANT TO SECTION 4B-1 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (K) "PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION" MEANS A SUM DISBURSED FROM THE FAIR CAMPAIGN FINANCING PUND TO A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (L) "SEED MONEY" MEANS A SUM OF LAWFULLY RAISED PRIVATE CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUAL PERSONS THAT IS THE GREATER OF EITHER \$250 OR 15 PERCENT OF THE MAXIMUM CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURE LIMIT PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 30-3 FOR A PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE SAME OFFICE.
- (M) "STATE BOARD" MEANS THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS.
- (N) "TREASURER" INCLUDES A CAMPAIGN SUBTREASURER.

 30-3. LIMITATIONS ON CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURES.
 - (A) EXPENDITURE LIMITS.

THE TREASURER OF A CANDIDATE MAY NOT EXPEND IN EXCESS OF THE FOLLOWING EXPENDITURE LIMITS ON BEHALF OF THE CANDIDATE FOR AN OFFICE IN AN ELECTION;
